The Resurrection of Christ: The Household of Faith, the Church

Opening Sentence

God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth. (John 4:24)

Opening Words

O Lord, open my lips and my mouth shall proclaim your praise.

Make me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

- 6 Father, of majesty unbounded, your true and only Son, worthy of all praise, the Holy Spirit, advocate and guide.

Part 2

- 7 You, Christ, are the King of glory, the eternal Son of the Father.
- 8 When you took our flesh to set us free, you humbly chose the Virgin's womb.

- 9 You overcame the sting of death and opened the kingdom of heaven to all believers.
- 10 You are seated at God's right hand in glory: we believe that you will come to be our judge.
- 11 Come then, Lord, and help your people, bought with the price of your own blood,
- 12 and bring us with your saints to glory everlasting.

Reading — Romans 12:1-2

I appeal to you therefore, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God—what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Apostles' Creed

In peace and unity may your people offer the unfailing sacrifice of praise, and make your glory known; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

O God of unchangeable power and eternal light, look favourably on your whole Church, that wonderful and sacred mystery, and by the tranquil operation of your perpetual providence carry out the work of our salvation: and let the whole world feel and see that things which were cast down are being raised up and things which had grown old are being made new and that all things are returning to perfection through him from whom they took their origin, even Jesus Christ our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God. now and for ever. **Amen**.
